Range Description

NATIVUS, a range that, as its name suggests, represents the 100% natural expression of the Averesti terroir and the rich symbols of Cucuteni culture.

Grape harvest

The grapes were harvested manually in the morning, at a sugar content of 230 g/l.

Vinification

The harvested grapes were introduced into the press, where a short pressing and low pressure was performed. The must was decanted by gravity at cold. The must was fermented in stainless steel tanks at a controlled temperature.

Wine philosophy

The story of Bohotin Busuioacei is lost in the mists of time, it is said that it is thousands of years old, that it was the wine of Stephen the Great, that there was very little initially, only a few dozen barrels and that very little wine was made and it was only released for special events, which made it memorable, amazing. We propose you to have a memorable experience with this wine and enjoy the aromas that have delighted important personalities in the history and culture of Romania and beyond.

Tasting notes

An intense pink wine, Busuioacă de Bohotin impresses with its vibrant and complex aroma, with dominant notes of basil, wildflowers, roses and ripe citrus. It has a sweet-sour taste, with a pleasant texture and a persistent finish, which underlines its unique and refined character.
